PARENT CONSENT & PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

I/We understand the components of the Individual Student Alternative Education Plan and agree that this program is in the best educational interest of the student.

Attendance & Participation Requirements

- Students may not exceed 18 absences during the academic year. Exceeding this limit may result in removal from the program due to truancy.
- Failure to comply with ISAEP requirements is a violation of compulsory attendance law.
- Students must demonstrate monthly academic progress through improved GED Ready® or Practice Test scores or by testing in GED subject areas.
- Parents/guardians will be informed regularly of student progress.
- Parents will be involved in any plan changes.
- Students may re-enroll in the regular high school program at any time.

ISAEP / GED Class Requirements

- Minimum age of 16
- Reading score of at least 7.5 grade equivalent with strong comprehension
- Pre-test scores of at least 550 in each of five subject areas
- Copy of birth certificate, government-issued photo ID, and Social Security card
- Required classroom materials (notebook, paper, pencils, pens)
- Compliance with compulsory attendance laws

GED Testing Requirements

- GED Ready® scores of at least 125 in each of the four subject areas
- Completion of Career Scope and employability skills coursework
- Minimum of 10 hours per week of verified work-based learning or enrollment in a technical career program
- Monthly progress reports from employer or program instructor
- GED testing fees: \$36 per subject (4 subjects total)
- GED Ready® practice test: \$6.99 per subject (Payment required at registration via credit or debit card)
